Bill's Bytes

Faith is the cornerstone of the Christian journey, one that traverses over the bridge of grace that God has built between His heart and ours. In Hebrews 11:6, Scripture powerfully declares, "And without faith, it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him." This verse encapsulates the essence of faith, showing not only its necessity but also its extraordinary reward.

Hebrews 11 is often referred to as the "Hall of Faith," a chapter filled with the lives of men and women who demonstrated unwavering trust in God's promises despite challenges and uncertainties. The faith they exhibited was not passive—it was active, lived out through obedience, perseverance, and reliance on God's Word. Abraham, Noah, Sarah, Moses, and others serve as timeless reminders that faith is inseparable from action. Their journeys exemplify the truth in Hebrews 11:6: God is pleased by faith and blesses those who genuinely seek Him.

This verse begins with a striking assertion—without faith, it is impossible to please God. The statement invites us to ponder: why does faith matter so deeply to God? Faith, at its core, is an acknowledgment of God's sovereignty and trustworthiness.



It is the lens through which we perceive God's nature and His work in the world. To please God, one must first believe in His existence—a belief that goes far beyond mere intellectual acknowledgment and transforms into heartfelt trust. Faith affirms that God is not distant nor indifferent but intimately involved in our lives.

Hebrews 11:6 also highlights the second essential aspect of faith: the conviction that God rewards those who seek Him. The reward of faith is not confined to material blessings but encompasses something far greater—eternal communion with God, spiritual fulfillment, and a life marked by His guidance and grace. God's reward is deeply personal, tailored to each believer's journey and need. He rewards those who seek Him earnestly, which speaks to an intentional and wholehearted pursuit of His presence. When we seek God with such diligence, it implies deep devotion. It requires a willingness to let go of doubt, fear, and the distractions of the world, focusing instead on God's promises. This pursuit involves prayer, meditation on Scripture, and being a doer of His word rather than a hearer only. Those who approach God in this manner experience His reward—not necessarily in the form of immediate answers or physical blessings, but through the profound peace, joy, and assurance of His presence.


Hebrews 11:6 serves as both encouragement and challenge. It assures believers that their faith is not in vain, that their trust and obedience are seen, approved and cherished by God. At the same time, it calls for a deeper commitment to live by faith daily, even when circumstances appear uncertain or daunting. Faith is more than a belief: it is an active trust in God's character and promises.

As God's beloved children, let us reflect on this truth: faith is pleasing to God, and His reward is unimaginably beyond what this world could ever hope to offer. May we continually seek Him, not out of obligation but from the overflow of hearts that long to know Him more. And in seeking Him, may we discover the boundless joy of His reward—an eternal relationship with our Creator and the fulfillment of His purposes in our lives upon the Earth.
